Abstract

This report seeks to provide a detailed understanding of Grenada's electoral process pursuant to the Grenada Constitution Order 1973 and the Representation of the People Act (RPA), Cap. 268A in the execution of the general election of June 23rd, 2022. The referenced legislations serve as the blueprint for ensuring free and fair elections, which is fundamental to our democratic process.

The Parliamentary Elections Office (PEO) usually consolidates its preparation for the holding of general elections approximately eighteen (18) months prior to the constitutionally due date for returning to the polls. The announcement of the June 23rd, 2022 general election meant that the referenced preparatory phase was slightly disrupted and as such the PEO had to expedite its preparation; thus averting any possible breaches of the legislation.

Many electors cited the early return to the polls as one that thwarted the electoral process. Despite the RPA allows for continuous registration, it was felt that some prospective electors were not allowed sufficient time to get registered, thus hindering their participation in the election. Advocates viewed this as unconstitutional and challenged its constitutionality in court. Moreover, the treatment of the expired voter identification card was another major issue as the RPA is void of a concise approach in addressing this concern.

During the electoral cycle under review the PEO attended to the concerns of major stakeholder groupings. There were limitations to adequately addressing some of the concerns, which require certain amendments to the RPA and Constitution. Subsequently, stakeholders sought redress through the court.

It is believed that the major concerns inhibiting the electoral process can be best addressed through constitution and electoral reform. These legislative changes will provide the regulatory framework for a seamless process of voter registration without compromising the integrity of the voters' register. However, the requisite changes desired for addressing our electoral concerns will require a high level of political maturity and quality investment.

Despite the concerns underscored, the 2022 general election was conducted well within the confines of the legislative framework governing our electoral process and was very peaceful.


Mission

To continuously register all eligible persons to vote, produce voters' identification cards, publish the list of Electors and to conduct Elections in accordance with Legislation.

Vision

Introduction

General election in Grenada was constitutionally due in 2023. As customary, the Parliamentary Elections Office (PEO) commences general preparation for elections approximately eighteen (18) months prior to this period. At the onset of the referenced period the PEO was challenged by the uncertainty brought on by the Covid-19 pandemic, which negatively impacted the replacement of expired voter identification cards. Given that the Representation of the People Act (RPA) Cap. 286A was silent in dealing with the expired voter identification card, the replacement of the expired cards was pursued as an administrative matter.

Subsequently, there was an attempt to address the issue of the expired voter identification cards by pursuing the appropriate amendments to the RPA. This process was aborted, citing insufficient time for achieving the necessary public awareness on the amendments. Hence the decision was taken to accept the expired voter identification card with the expiry date 31st January 2020 as part of the verification process for electors.

Within less than a month after the commencement of the replacement of the expired identification cards, the Assistant Supervisor of Elections (ASOE), Mrs. Venus Pierre resigned effective February 28th, 2020. Her resignation presented a major challenge for the timely processing and delivery of voter identification cards as the post remained vacant for over a year.

During this election cycle, the following officers were appointed, Supervisor of Elections, Assistant Supervisor of Elections, three Registration Officers and an Assistant Registration Officer. The PEO established a second Parliamentary Constituency Office at Perdmontemps, St. David to service the southern part of this constituency.

The management of the PEO developed a blueprint for the execution of the 2022 general elections. This plan of action incorporated the procurement of election materials and services, education and training, public relations, site visits and stakeholders' engagements. The level of preparation employed by the PEO was very instrumental in the smooth execution of the 2022 general election. Noteworthy of mention are the strategies pursued in the training of poll workers, the Public Service Announcements (PSA), and the unwavering commitment of the staff in the execution of their duties.

Overall, the PEO was very satisfied with the execution of the 2022 general election and wishes to commend the entire population for the attainment of this feat. However, the PEO's efforts to pursue genuine reform of the electoral system is to some extent constrained within the constitution.

Training

The PEO recognized that targeted training of each poll worker was instrumental in maintaining the consistency of practice in the execution of the election. The training material was developed through a PowerPoint presentation by staff at the Central Office. The initial training session was designed and delivered to poll workers of each constituency as a cohort.

The services of two (2) expert facilitators were procured, namely, Mrs. Meryl Lord and Mr. Cecil Johnson. Those facilitators were supported by dedicated officers from the Central Office. The training schedule facilitated two (2) sessions per day, which ran simultaneously led by the expert facilitators. The training sessions commenced on 3rd May, 2022 and concluded on 16th May, 2022. The initial training session for the Constituency of Carriacou and Petit Martinique was facilitated by Mr. Michael Millette, Systems Administrator attached to the Central Office.

Subsequently, each Returning Officer held training sessions to further hone the skills of their respective poll workers. There were many collaborative training sessions among the respective Returning Officers, where they utilized strategies of role play and quizzes. Mr. Glen Alexander, Returning Officer was very instrumental in facilitating training sessions for his colleagues. Additionally, many of the Returning Officers employed a training modality of train the trainers as a capacity building mechanism.

The culmination of the training exercise was delivered by Mr. Elvis Morain, Supervisor of Elections (SOE) and Mr. Michael Millette, Systems Administrator, who were ably assisted by officers from the Central Office. The facilitators made short presentations, which were followed by a question-and-answer session. These sessions were delivered from 13th June, 2022 through to 15th June, 2022 at three (3) different locations throughout the State of Grenada.

Legislative Amendments

The Representation of the People Act, Cap. 286A, was amended by the Representation of the People (Amendment) Act No. 13 of 2018. This amendment saw the insertion of the new rule “4A. Proof of ordinary residence”. This amendment served to strengthen the verification process of applicants who are desirous of being electors; especially the ones requesting transfer to another constituency. The enforcement of the referenced amendment assisted in minimizing the incidence of voter padding.

Another notable amendment was sub-section (5) of section 39 of the principal act, which saw the change in nomination deposit from three hundred Eastern Caribbean Dollars (EC\$300.00) to five hundred Eastern Caribbean Dollars (EC\$500.00). The prospective candidates were also required to present to the Returning Officer an original official receipt from the treasury or revenue office

evidencing payment unlike the payment of such deposit in cash to the Returning Officer which was done previously.

Voter Education and Awareness

The issue of voter education and awareness is a critical component of the Parliamentary Elections Office's work. Consequently, the PEO's Human Resource construct underscores the need for the employment of a Civic and Voter Registration Officer to facilitate the referenced function. Mr. Ferdinand Phillip being the current holder of this position engaged the public through various media platforms. Mr. Phillip appeared on most of the popular current affairs' programmes featured on radio and television. His engagements focused on sensitization of the populace in areas of the electoral system, the amendments of the RPA, the replacement of expired voter identification cards and rights and responsibilities of stakeholders.

Mr. Phillip's work was ably supported by the Supervisor of Elections and the Systems Administrator, who appeared as panelists on many of the media conferences held by the PEO. Those media conferences dealt with concerns related to voter registration and the integrity of the process in ensuring free and fair general elections.

The website organized by the Parliamentary Elections Office www.peogrenada.org continued to be a repository for archiving documents governing Grenada's Electoral System. These documents include the RPA, Cap. 286A, and its suite of amendments, the publications of the voters list, electoral constituencies and polling divisions and Constituency Offices.

The PEO continued to employ the use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) in its voter education and awareness efforts. The services of a digital media entity were procured in the production of a series of public service announcements for distribution on the electronic media platforms. These messages were well received, and the PEO was commended for its efforts.

Throughout the election cycle the PEO had many engagements with stakeholders. The engagements were very cordial and formed a basis for mutual exchanges on the way forward for an improved electoral system.

Moreover, the PEO through the desk of the Civic and Voter Registration Officer was instrumental in addressing the concerns of the public. Those exchanges also provided useful information for improving the office's image. Unfortunately, the onset of the Covid 19 pandemic inhibited the PEO's engagement with the schools.

Polling Station Changes

As is customary the PEO through its Registration/Returning Officers assessed the polling divisions and stations used in prior general elections to determine the suitability of these facilities for the upcoming election. The accommodation and access for people who are differently abled are key variables in asserting the suitability of these facilities.

Additionally, given that the general election was scheduled on a date, which coincided with the sitting of CAPE and CSEC examinations, alternate facilities were identified and designated as polling stations.

Having assessed all the polling stations used during the last election the following changes were facilitated for the June 23rd general election:

St. Andrew South East

- B01 – St. Andrew Anglican Secondary School was replaced by Telescope Primary School
- B10 – Hansel Japal’s Residence was replaced by Mamma Cannes Community Centre

St. Andrew North East

- D03 – Pearl’s Community Centre was replaced by Grenada Christian Academy

St. David

- F01 – Perdmontemps Health Centre was replaced by Communal Credit Union Building, Perdmontemps, St. David

Town of St. George

- G05 – St. Joseph’s Convent on upper Church Street was replaced by Norton Hall, Church Street

St. George North West

- J02 - La Qua Building in Grand Mal was replaced by Pier 57 Restaurant, Grand Mal

St. George South

- L07 – Sandino Block Plant was replaced by Blessed Sacrament R. C. School

St. John

- M07 - Cocoa Grove Community Centre was replaced by Florida Government School

St. Mark

- N03 - Victoria Hotel was replaced by Victoria Child Development Centre

St. Patrick West

- R05 – Mc Donald College Secondary School was replaced by St. Patrick R. C. School.

Notice of place and time of election

Pursuant to the dissolution of Parliament on Monday 16th May 2022, Her Excellency the Governor General issued writs to fifteen (15) Returning Officers appointed under Section 29(3) of the Representation of the People Act Cap. 286A, to conduct General Elections in fifteen (15) constituencies on Thursday 23rd June 2022 in the State of Grenada. These writs were issued on Tuesday 17th May 2022 and notices of the issue of such writs were published on Wednesday 18th May 2022. Nomination day was set for Wednesday the 1st day of June 2022 at 9:00 a.m. The Special Polling Day was scheduled for Monday 20th, June 2022.

In accordance with RPA Rule 21, no registration of electors is allowed after the issuance of the writs by Her Excellency the Governor General until after the general election. Hence the final day for voter registration was Monday 16th May 2022.

Nomination Day

The process of nomination of candidates for the June 23rd, 2022 General Election was well executed in keeping with the provisions of the RPA. The Returning Officers, political parties and the independent candidate must be commended for their efforts in managing the process.

At the close of the nomination process, forty-one (41) candidates were nominated to contest the election. The National Democratic Congress (NDC) and the New National Party (NNP) nominated fifteen (15) candidates each. The Grenada United Labour Party (GULP) nominated four (4) candidates. The Grenada Renaissance Party (GRP) and the Independent Freedom Party (IFP) nominated three (3) candidates each. There was one (1) independent candidate.

The Grenada Renaissance Party (GRP) had nomination documents dropped through courier service at three (3) Parliamentary Constituency Elections Offices namely, St. John, Town of St. George and Carriacou and Petit Martinique. Unfortunately, those candidates did not satisfy the requirements for nomination.

Engagements with International Election Observers

The Caribbean Community (CARICOM) and the Organization of American States (OAS) mounted election observation missions for Grenada's General Election. The CARICOM team was headed by the Chief of Mission, Mr. John Jarvis, and comprised of (10) members. The OAS team was headed by the Chief of Mission, Dr. Rosina Wiltshire and comprised of fourteen (14) members, two of whom were engaged virtually.

Three (3) members of the CARICOM observation mission led by its Chief of Mission paid a courtesy call to the Supervisor of Elections, Saturday 18th June 2022. During the engagement, Mr. Jarvis provided a brief overview of the mission's expectations and provided expert guidance on the conduct of general elections.

Similarly, selected members of the OAS mission led by their Chief of Mission paid a courtesy call to the Supervisor of Elections. The engagement focused on the mission's expectations, and the implementation of recommendations from previous observation missions. The engagement culminated with the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between the OAS and the PEO with respect to the mounting of the mission.

For the ensuing period, which culminated with the recounting of the ballots, both observer teams engaged with various officers involved in the electoral process. The teams commended the PEO for its preparation in the conduct of the June 23rd, 2022, general election.

Special Polling Day

In accordance with section 43 of the Representation of the People Act, Cap. 286A, Special Polling Day is the day designated for police officers to cast their ballot. Special polling stations were established in the fifteen (15) constituencies and nine hundred and fourteen (914) police officers were eligible to vote on that day. The PEO was very pleased with the execution of the special polling day.

Court Matters

The PEO through the Supervisor of Elections was named as one of the defendants in three (3) court matters filed in the Supreme Court of Grenada and the West Indies Associated States High Court of Justice (Civil). Those were constitutional matters brought before the court by Mr. Martin W. Edwards, Political Leader of Grenada Renaissance Party (GRP); Mr. John Rulow and Independent Caucus for Constitution Reform; Power Grenada and Grenada Empowerment Movement.

The matter filed by Mr. Edwards was heard by Her Ladyship, the Honorable Madame Justice Agnes Actie on June 21st, 2022. The matter was dismissed.

The matters filed by Mr. Rulow and the Independent Caucus for Constitution Reform, Power Grenada and Grenada Empowerment Movement were heard by His Lordship, Honorable Justice Raulston Glasgow June 22nd, 2022. Those matters were dismissed and withdrawn respectively.

Election Day

The commencement of the polls was in keeping with the provisions of the RPA. The number of eligible voters stood at eighty-seven thousand, five hundred and sixty-six (87,566). Ballots were cast throughout the State of Grenada in fifteen (15) constituencies subdivided into two hundred and eighty-five (285) polling stations and managed by six hundred and eighty-eight (688) poll workers.

The International Observation Mission teams were present throughout the State of Grenada, at random polling stations where they observed the electoral process unfolded as well as operations at the PEO, Central Office including the reporting of the results. As evident by the preliminary report of the OAS, generally there was a commendable level of satisfaction with the execution of the election.

As expected, scores of electors were present at all polling stations throughout the State to cast their ballots. Long queues were evident way into the mid-morning period at most polling stations, which subsided as the day progressed. In some polling stations, electors expressed a degree of frustration with what appeared to be the tardiness of the voting process, which was in part attributed to physical and or other challenges experienced by the electors.

The PEO received calls indicating that some electors could not be found on the official register at the polling stations. Subsequently, it was determined that most of those electors showed up at the wrong polling stations, a few were omitted pursuant to the preparation for the publication of the official list and one of the individuals was not duly registered. The electors who were inadvertently omitted had their registration status rectified through the issuance of addenda to the voter register.

Throughout the day the process was relatively smooth, especially during the afternoon session. The closing of the polls was in keeping with the legislation, which allows for electors who are in line at 5 pm to cast their ballot. Nonetheless, most polling stations were not burdened with extensive queues nearing the closing of the polls, which made the process rather seamless.

The first set of preliminary election results were broadcasted at 5.39 pm and thereafter the public received the numbers seamlessly as the results of the various constituencies were delivered subject to the recount as per the legislation. Subsequently, the Supervisor of Elections was joined by the Civic and Voter Registration Officer, who communicated the preliminary results to

the Public via the Government Information Service (GIS). The preliminary results indicated that the National Democratic Congress (NDC) led by Mr. Dickon Mitchell won nine (9) of the fifteen (15) seats and the New National Party (NNP) led by Dr. Keith Mitchell won the remaining six (6) seats.

Post-Election Day

Although Friday 24th June 2022 was declared a public holiday the final count was taken on that day. The recount was conducted as per the legislation. There were a few minor changes in the preliminary numbers, which did not influence any changes in the overall outcome of the election.

A total of sixty thousand, eight hundred and fifty-three (60,853) individuals casted their ballot, which represented a voter turnout of sixty-nine point four nine percent (69.49%).

The PEO continued with its administrative processes relative to the election, the processing of all payments for goods and services, the issuance of certificates for refund of nomination deposit, communicating expression of thanks and congratulatory messages.

The PEO is also in receipt of a notice of appeal by the Appellant John Rulow, who is appealing against the judgment of the Honorable Justice Raulston Glasgow delivered on the 22nd of June 2022.

Conclusion and Next Steps

The June 23rd general election garnered much public interest from the onset of the political campaign as the main political parties engaged the populace. During this period the electorate was urged to get registered as well as to have their expired voter identification cards replaced. Consequently, the Parliamentary Constituency Elections Offices witnessed a significant increase in applications for voter registration.

The PEO sought to intensify its public awareness on the registration process as well as urged eligible voters to get registered. Through its many media engagements and Public Service Announcements (PSA), the PEO was able to assert a level of comfort among the populace as many of their queries were addressed in a timely manner.

One of the major issues that is a grave challenge to the PEO, is the lack of adequate time to process the claims and objections submitted within the timeframe provided for between the publications of the current and official lists of voters. The legislation provides for a very detailed process for adequately addressing claims and objections and given the time sensitive

processes leading up to a general election, it is practically impossible to deal with this issue as per the legislation.

Despite the challenges underscored, the PEO is satisfied that the 2022 general election was conducted within the confines of the legislation, which resulted in a seamless and peaceful process. However, the PEO believes that the following needs to be addressed within this election cycle to avert these issues before the next constitutionally due general election:

1. Genuine constitution and electoral reform
2. Procurement of an updated electronic voters' registration system
3. Consolidation of the amendments of the RPA
4. Reconstituting of the Constituency Boundaries Commission
5. Conduct of a national enumeration exercise
6. Strengthening of recruitment and selection process of poll workers
7. Develop a training manual for poll workers
8. Conduct a functional review of the Parliamentary Elections Office.

It is important that a concerted effort is made to address these issues within the first two and a half years of the election cycle to afford adequate public awareness of the changes.

Demographic Analysis





Chart showing % of persons voting by age range
